



Casual Players

Introduction

From time-to-time people come to the TBA for a casual game of bridge. The Tasmanian Bridge Association (TBA) is happy to accommodate this on a limited basis as we always want to encourage membership of the club if people intend to play on a regular basis.

Purpose

This policy outlines how the TBA deals with situations where people want to play casually at the club.

Scope

This policy applies to all situations where someone, who is not a member of the TBA, wants to play on a casual basis.

Policy

- The TBA welcomes non-members to the club for the occasional game of bridge.
- However, the TBA does not support people playing over the long-term without being members of the club, or a member of another bridge club in Australia.
- International visitors may also want to play casually at the TBA whilst they are in Tasmania. They will not have an ABF number so will not accrue masterpoints but are welcome to play at the club.
- A person may play at the TBA casually up to ten times after which we require them to become a member. This allocation of times played may be varied at the digression of the Committee depending on specific circumstances.

- Casual players will pay full table money. They are not eligible for any concession rates.
